

Arab and Jewish Immigrants in Latin America: Images and Realities

First of all, it appears that Western and Eastern European Jews played insignificant roles in the San Pedro Sula commercial and industrial economy during the period under discussion. Key Jewish personalities of the post-1940s period, the Rosenthals, Goldsteins, and Brandels, only appear in official and commercial documents after 1930. They invested primarily in dry goods stores, although some investments by the Goldsteins and Weizenbluts did go into a small hide tanning operation.¹⁰⁴ Needless to say, Jewish immigrants never matched the economic power accumulated by the Arab Palestinian population in this period. Finally, it appears that the Rosenthals, Goldsteins, Brandels, and perhaps others, did not begin as itinerant rural pedlars as their Arab predecessors did. In fact, it seems most Jews resident in Honduras in the 1940s arrived twenty to thirty years after the Palestinian Colony assumed the importance detailed earlier.
